### 2,500 acre SEZ to be setup at Hardware Park Near New International Airport, Hyderabad

Aiming to achieve a 40 per cent growth in IT/ITES exports and provide additional 30,000 jobs by next year, the government announced a series of initiatives, including a 2,500 acre special economic zone (SEZ) at hardware park on the city outskirts and appointment of four nodal officers for Tier-II cities.

The Government intends to make Andhra Pradesh Hardware hub of the country by establishing SEZ at the hardware Park and developing hardware manufacturing cluster for non-SEZ units, the Secretary IT & Communications, K. Ratna Prabha, said. She further said that IT/ITES exports were likely to cross Rs. 11,500 crores. Private land owners will be given incentives to develop IT parks by aggregating 25 acres in the peripheries of a city and five acres in the core area of a city.

Such parks will get exception from urban ceiling on payment of the prescribed fee and IT companies occupying them will be eligible for 100 per cent re-imbursment of stamp duty and registration fee.

#### Nodal Officers

Stating that the Government envisaged an even geographical spread of the IT Industry, she announced the appointment of nodal officers for establishing the growth of IT in Tier-II cities. The following officers will be the single point contact to the industry: Praveen Kumar ( Visakapatnam & Kakinada), Gopi Krishna (Tirupati), Raghuvveer (Warangal) and T.V. Parthasarathi (Vijayawada)

With a projected requirement of 30 million square feet of built space by 2009 for deploying IT industry, she said the Government was intending a multidimensional approach in making real estate available to the industry. It was decided that land will be allotted in Hyderabad only to mega IT companies.

In the Tier-II cities, incubation centres will be developed by the Government & STPI will make available space to entrepreneurs and IT companies. IT towers will be constructed at Vishakapatnam and Tirupati.

She announced that special incentives to Tier-II cities of Rs. 50 Lakh subsidy to the first five anchor companies employing 250 persons in IT or 500 employees in ITES. Alternatively Rs. 15 lakhs recruitment assistance will be given for employing 100 persons in IT or 200 in ITES.
